Parents, your signed consent is required.

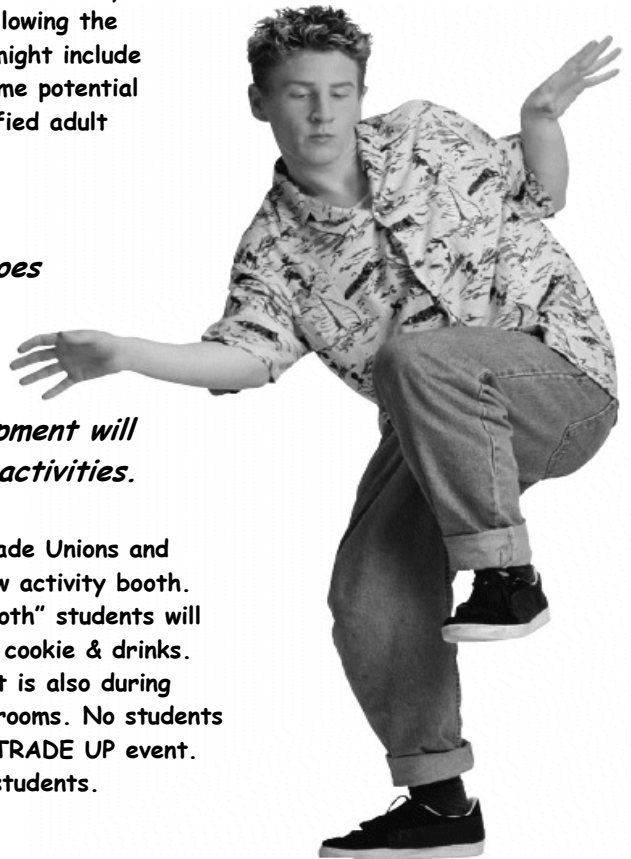
Parents, the school must return this signed consent form from you allowing the student to participate in the hands-on activities. These activities might include welding, soldering, bricklaying, nail guns, electricity and may pose some potential risk for accidents. All activities are supervised by trained and qualified adult instructors in their field of expertise.

During TRADE UP the student will be required to wear:

- *Full-length pants (no shorts or skirts), regular shoes (no open-toed shoes, flip flops or sandals)*
- *Students will be given safety equipment to wear such as a hard-hat and safety eyeglasses.*

Failure to meet this dress code or wear the safety equipment will NOT allow the student to participate in the "hands-on" activities.

At TRADE UP 2010, there will be 12 activity booths including 10 Trade Unions and Parkland College. The students will rotate every 20 minutes to a new activity booth. These rotations will also include 2 break booths. During a "break booth" students will receive a box lunch or snack that includes drinks, sandwich, chips or cookie & drinks. Students are NOT permitted to bring their own food and drinks. It is also during these break sessions that students will be permitted to use the restrooms. No students will be permitted to leave the property or immediate vicinity of the TRADE UP event. Discipline will be handled by the adult chaperones accompanying the students.



2010 Trade Up Consent Agreement
